Minuteman Founder Endorses Sam Peters for US Congress

Gilchrist alerts voters that Sam Peters has a plan that works

Aliso Viejo, CA – Minuteman Project Founder and President Jim Gilchrist, the nation's leading grassroots activist on the issue of immigration reform and border security, announced he is endorsing Sam Peters in the Republican Primary in Nevada's Fourth Congressional District. Gilchrist cited Peters' 11 Point Plan never supporting amnesty, eliminating Sanctuary Cities, and building a wall that will secure our borders with Mexico. Polls show that immigration reform and border security remains one of the top issues facing voters of the state of Nevada in the upcoming June 14 Republican Primary.

Gilchrist stated, "Sam Peters will demand both the Federal and State Government to enforce our laws and our borders. Sam truly has a committed stand on the issues of immigration reform and border security and is just the leader Nevada and America needs to end the chaos of illegal immigration."

Gilchrist continued, "I am also excited that Sam has developed a comprehensive 11-Point Plan to immediately confront and fix our immigration problems. For too long law abiding Americans have grown tired of watching the political establishment lack the will to enforce our nation's laws when it comes to border security, immigration policy, and sanctuary cities. Nevada needs someone in Washington DC that will fight on behalf of taxpayers to end the influx of illegal aliens in America, and that is why I wholeheartedly endorse Sam Peters for US Congress."

The Peters 11 Point Plan:

1. Finish the wall,
2. Hold elected officials who violate our federal immigration laws legally accountable,
3. End chain migration for non-immediate family members,
4. Discourage the formation of sanctuary cities and states by holding back federal funding,
5. End the visa lottery system,
6. Prohibit illegal aliens from receiving taxpayer-funded welfare and health care benefits, housing and transportation,
7. Increase penalties on businesses that knowingly hire illegal aliens,

8. Require mandatory employer verification of worker eligibility,
9. Reduce refugee and visa fraud by re-evaluating criteria and improving background checks,
10. End visa overstays, and
11. Enact merit-based immigration reform to expedite the naturalization process.

Jim Gilchrist founded the multi-ethnic Minuteman Project on Oct. 1, 2004, after years of frustrated efforts trying to get a neglectful U.S. government to simply enforce existing immigration laws. He was one of the original campaign endorsers of President Trump in the summer of 2015.
